




They had a special friend, **Captain Green**.

Ben was on his way to school. He couldn't wait to learn new things and play with his friends.









It was not a fun day because Arul had to sit far away from his friends in class.

Captain Green took a look at Arul and shook his head.




Arul thought hard about where he went over the past few days. Was he...










ZZZ... The noise grew louder. Ouch! Something bit Arul and he felt itchy all over.





"This is a mosquito," Captain Green explained.


"When it is hungry, it may bite you!

Do not scratch it or it may bleed, Arul!"








Off they went and they started picking up litter and

After wiping her nose, Dina happily threw the tissue and walked away.








Then, Aryl went home to rest.
